
The illustrations for the Rochester booklet comprise eight views and a plan. Three of the blocks had been made several years earlier, for Fergusson's 'Handbook of architecture' (1855), also published by Murray: they were all engraved from drawings by George Scharf. The new illustrations made for the present book were the work of Orlando Jewitt. These drawings, we are told, were 'made on the spot by Mr. Jewitt, who has also engraved most of them, with the assistance of photographs' (preface, part I, p. iv). That seems to apply to four of the Rochester views, which all carry Jewitt's signature. One view is left unaccounted for – the view of the cloister (Plate VI) – about which I have nothing definite to say.

As for the plan, that was copied (without acknowledgment) from the plan drawn by Robert Garland for 'Winkles's Cathedrals' (1836).






King 1861, frontispiece.




King 1861, plan.








